- Provide direct 1:1 ABA Therapy to children ages 2-14 years old in the center and in-home environments.

- Help learners manage challenging behaviors by implementing treatment plans across multiple domains; including communication, social behavior, learner readiness skills, self care, replacement behavior and behavior reduction as instructed by BCBA.
- Collect and record data on their daily progress.
- Toilet training and diaper changing may be required.
- Participate in staff meetings, team meetings and collaborate with other technicians and BCBAs.
