

Job description

Join Rise Up for Autism School Based BCBA's.

We are seeking a BCBA (Board Certified Behavioral Analyst) to join our team in schools located in Joliet! This is a salary position that will run from August - May. You will be required to be on site between 1 or 2 schools maximum from 8-3:30 pm.

The School BCBA is responsible for overseeing RUFA's school contract. They will work collaboratively with the school teachers and administration, as well as with RUFA's clinical leadership, to ensure proper support is provided to the school district. This includes providing teachers guidance with specific students, classroom structure, creating FBAs and BIPs, training teachers and DSP, and providing general positive behavior intervention and supports (PBIS) within the classroom.

Key responsibilities for the position are listed below. This job description describes essential job functions but does not provide an exhaustive list of duties that may be assigned.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Effectively collaborate and train school personnel, teachers, paraprofessionals, and administrative staff.
- Provide BCBA consultation and training to classrooms/teachers/students as needed or requested by The District.
- Maintain a relationship with all school stakeholders and continually evaluate ways we can provide supports to the district.
- Establish exit criteria for current supports in place and partner with the school to fade out interventions as necessary.
- Provide real-time data and regular reports to the district, as agreed upon by the district and RUFA.
- Provide staff training as requested on various Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) topics.

- Maintain at least monthly in-person contact with the district representative to provide updates on RUFA services and any collaborative efforts that might be required.
- Report to RUFA's Clinical Director on a regular basis to provide updates on provision of services to the district.
- Additional specific responsibilities will be dependent on the specific services requested by the district.

- Masters in applied behavior analysis, or related fields
- Current BCBA certification
- Completion of BACB's supervision training requirements required
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working with children with autism; preferred
- Prior supervisory experience; preferred
- Minimum of 1 year experience working within the school setting; preferred
- Excellent communication skills (verbal and written)
- Excellent computer skills and knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite (Excel, Word, Outlook)
- Must pass a criminal background check per school district requirement
- Ability to perform occasional lifting of 50 pounds, work in various positions, and perform various tasks such as running, jumping, and bending etc.
